### Year 6 home learning tasks

As we prepare children for secondary school and beyond, the role of home learning becomes increasingly important. Therefore, we set a very structured programme to help with this preparation.

In addition to this work, children will be invited at different points to additional sessions of targeted support.

As this is can be a year when children might feel some pressure as they grow up, parents and carers can support their children's learning by helping their children to complete tasks at home. We don't expect parents to do the work for children - but ensuring that children have access to a desk/table, a quiet space and a regular routine (as well as 8 hours of sleep a night) is very important. If ever there are concerns, please do not hesitate to contact the class teacher.

### Year 6 expectations for homework:

Monday: Reading comprehension (due in on Thursday).

Tuesdays: Maths task focusing on written methods (due in on Wednesday).

Wednesdays: Learning of times tables/division facts (test on Tuesday).

Thursdays: Punctuation and grammar task (due in on Monday).

Fridays: Learning of spellings and using spelling words in sentences (test on Friday).

We would love to think that children read every evening too for fifteen minutes - simply for pleasure. The value of a good book at bedtime cannot be overstated!

We do expect that both parents/carers and teachers sign the planners on a weekly basis to ensure that reading is being monitored. It is also another channel of communication for parents/carers!
