



### **Our 'Gold' partnership with The Plymouth Centre for Faith and Cultural Diversity**

#### **Context:**

As a Gold partner of The Plymouth Centre for Faith and Cultural Diversity, we believe that it is important for young people to experience as many enriching experiences as possible. We believe that to prepare children for their lives in modern Britain, it is crucial to have an awareness, an understanding and an appreciation of other cultures.

#### **Provision:**

Therefore, all year groups benefit from:

- 7 assemblies per year led by religious speakers. These assemblies have included speakers from the Muslim, Hindu and Jewish Faiths;
- 1 visit to a place of religious worship per year. This means that over seven years of primary education, the children will have visited a range of churches, synagogues, temples, mosques and centres.
- 1 workshop led by a cultural leader per year. This means that over seven years of primary education, the children will have benefited from seven different workshops. This year, booked workshops have included sessions on meditation, Japanese culture, the holocaust and aboriginal didgeridoos!

As a set of experiences, we believe that this provision will help promote an understanding of the rich and wonderful world around us.
